NCYC 101

What is NCYC?

Occurring every two years, NCYC is a gathering of over 23,000 teens from across the country to praise God and celebrate their Catholic faith for 3 days.

Who is it for?

Teens in grades 9-12. Chaperones must be 21+. Young adults 18-20 may attend under certain conditions.

Where is NCYC?

NCYC 2009 will be back in Kansas City (last time was 1997). We will fill the Sprint Center and overflow into Municipal Auditorium. Also, the whole Convention Center will be used for workshops, a 70,000 square foot thematic park "Reign Forest," and food court.

How much does it cost?

Each diocese sets a base cost, which includes the registration fee of \$195, and goes up based on hotel, travel and other expenses.

How do I sign up?

Register through your parish youth minister or pastor, or contact your diocesan office to find the closest participating parish.
