## Code of Behavior 2008-2009

At all CTK sponsored activities, we expect you to represent Christ the King Church well. We hope that you will display the mature, responsible leadership and character which has for so many years been the trademark of Catholic youth within our parish.

- Attend Mass regularly.
- No inappropriate clothing - see the CYM Dress Code.
- Smoking, chewing tobacco, drugs or alcohol will not be permitted.
- Matches, cigarette lighters or items that would endanger people, pets, wildlife or property will not be permitted.
- Inappropriate language, fighting, vandalism or weapons will not be permitted at any time.
- Individuals are responsible for their own actions and will be asked to assume the natural consequences for any negative behavior. Each participant will take full responsibility for any damage or theft.
- Christ-like behavior is promoted and expected at all times. Therefore, inappropriate contact, touch, gesture, language or activity of a sexual nature is unacceptable.
- You must respect and abide by the rules of the Adult Advisory Board (AAB) at all CYM activities. There will be no tolerance for rude and disrespectful behavior toward any adult volunteers.

Infractions of the Code of Behavior will result in a meeting with the Youth Director and a phone call to parents. Depending on the severity of the problem, the participant may be asked to leave the activity and/or lose CYM privileges.
